MARINA KASTELLA TO TROGIR

SATURDAY

The group should fly into Split, known for its Riva and the fortress like complex at its center, Diocletian's Palace. Upon arrival, meet at the marina for introductions and to get familiar with the yacht. This evening we'll have a sunset sail to the historical town of Trogir for a dinner of local fish and wine. Trogir is a great ancient town and UNESCO world heritage site.

TROGIR TO KOMIŽA

SUNDAY

Today is a full day of sailing heading SW from Trogir to Komiža, a city on the west side of the island, Vis. Komiža is a nice quaint town, a typical Mediterranean village, with beautiful beaches, narrow roads and houses squeezed together around the harbor. On our way to Komiža we'll stop at the Blue Lagoon to swim and be in awe of the crystal-clear water of the Adriatic. Tonight, after dinner on board, grab a legendary gelato on the riva.

KOMIŽA TO VIS

MONDAY

One of many highlights for guests is the Blue Cave on the island of Biševo. Go cliff jumping, swim inside the cave or ride the dinghy to take pictures of this amazing natural phenomenon. The afternoon will be spent sailing to Vis, which was for many years the military and naval headquarters of Tito's army and was closed to the public until 1989. Moor up at the wall in Vis to access the excellent restaurants, fortress, monastery and wineries. Tonight, we eat at Darko's, a legendary restaurant where there are only a couple tables and the food is cooked and prepared all day for the guests. A true taste of the Croatian culinary culture.







VIS TO ŠĆEDRO

TUESDAY

From Vis, we sail to the island of Šćedro, a protected nature park with many hidden coves and excellent anchorages. We will stop for a swim or two along the way to enjoy the natural beauty Croatia offers. Feel free to take the helm and practice your new sailing skills. Once we moor in the bay, grab the SUP for a paddle, take a snorkel or lay out on the deck. For dinner, we'll have a gourmet dinner on board.

ŠĆEDRO TO HVAR

WEDNESDAY

Today we sail from Šćedro to Hvar. On the way, we'll knock out some serious halyard swings and then stop off and visit the islands of Paklinski Otoci. Our aim is an early afternoon arrival at Hvar in order to walk up to the castle, visit the town and see the sunset from the Hula Hula Beach Bar. Dinner is either on board or onshore depending on the group's preference.





HVAR TO SOLTA THURSDAY

We have a lazy morning, perhaps with fresh chocolate croissants and smoothies before heading to the "third bay from the right", a beautiful bay on the south end of Šolta for a swim. The afternoon we'll sail to the west end of the island to a large natural bay. Here we'll med-moor, a traditional mooring technique used in this region of the world. The water stays so deep right up until the rocks, that when you are there it'll seem you can reach out and touch the shore. Dinner is on shore, on the top of the hill. Another beautiful sunset looking over the bay.

ŠOLTA TO SPLIT FRIDAY

Today we must return the boat back to the marina. Before that however, we will enjoy our last morning onboard by swimming, relaxing and taking in the scenery. In the afternoon, once the boat is moored, we'll head into visit the city of Split and celebrate our trip at one of the excellent restaurants located on the riva.

Unfortunately, today we must leave our beloved yacht and head off to new adventures. It was a pleasure having you all onboard and we look forward to sailing with you again in the near future!
